



HOUSEHOLD GOODS NOT ACCEPTED FOR SHIPPING OR STORAGE

Hazardous materials are not accepted for shipping. The US Department of Transportation defines and identifies what is and what is not considered to be “hazardous” material. Some common hazardous household goods include:

1. Flammables

- Paints, Varnish (Varnish Removers) or Wool Oil Stains
- Petro-chemical Based Garden Sprays
- Charcoal Briquettes
- Lighter Fluid
- Propane/Butane/Gasoline
- Signal Flares
- Matches

2. Combustible Liquids

- Lubricants (Motor Oils)
- Anti-Freeze Compounds
- Alcohols (e.g. – Rubbing)

3. Compressed Gases

- Aerosol Cans
- Fire Extinguishers
- Scuba Diving Tanks

4. Corrosives

- Bleach
- Drain Cleaner
- Batteries (Wet or Dry)
- Acids
- Photographic Acids Used to Develop Film
- Water Purifying Agents Used in Swimming Pools



5. Explosives

Small Arms Ammunition
Fireworks
Flash Bulbs

6. Live Plants, Seeds, Fresh Fruits or Flowers, Pet Food, Meat

Be aware that the above items cannot be transported with your household goods.

7. Prohibited Items

Pornographic Material
Narcotics and Drugs
Unprocessed furs and skins

In addition to hazardous materials, the following items must be removed prior to the packers' arrival.

Jewelry
Legal Documents
Money
Watches
Trading Stamps
Coin Collections
Furs
Other items and collections of high value
